(July 12, 2019) – Senior Services’ Medicare benefits counselors will hold information and assistance events throughout Western Tidewater in August 2019 to assist Medicare-eligible individuals navigating Medicare and Medicare Part D. Assistance will also be available for those who are currently enrolled and may be eligible for the Part D Low-Income Subsidy “Extra Help” benefit.
